The Numbers

- 2.10% Budget Increase
 - \$13,652,378 >>> \$13,939,687
 - \$287,309 Increase
- What impacts the budget:
 - Contractual Increase
 - Instructional: 3.00%
 - Non-Instructional: 3.25%
 - Benefits
 - Health Insurance: 1.75% Increase
 - TRS: Increase from 8.86% to 9.53%
 - ERS: Increase from 15.90% to 16.20%
 - Improvements
 - Playground
 - Flooring
 - Bus Bond from 2019-20 Purchase

COVID Impact

- \$150,000 Pandemic Deduction
 - To be reimbursed by CARES Act
- "Look Back Periods:
 - April 1 April 30
 - May 1 June 30
 - July 1 Dec 31
- MAY impact Current Year Aid
- Budget includes a \$90k deduction in state aid from final aid run



Tax Cap & Preliminary Proposal

Allowable Increase (Decrease) in Dollars	\$121,933
Allowable Increase (Decrease) in %	1.61%

Proposing 1.90% Tax Increase (\$144,022) Max Previously Proposed Tax Increase 2.90%

• Requires Voter Override
