**ALEXANDRIA CENTRAL SCHOOL BUDGET VOTE/BOARD MEMBER ELECTION  
May 16, 2023**

**Proposition #1**

We, the undersigned do hereby assert that the result for the Alexandria Central School District to be authorized to extend the sum set forth in the budget for the 2023-2024 school year in the total amount of \$15,902,241 and to access and levy upon the taxable property of the District the necessary tax therefore. The vote results held on this day, Tuesday, May 16, 2023 are as follows:

**Proposition #2**

Resolved, the Board of Education of the Alexandria Central School District shall be authorized to issue bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time, in the principal amount **not to exceed \$300,000**, or so much thereof as may be necessary, and apply a grant awarded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in the amount of seven-hundred ten thousand dollars together with any other aid received by the District and the proceeds of such bonds, notes, to purchase two student transport vehicles and one passenger vehicle, including necessary furnishings, fixtures and equipment and all other costs incidental thereto, at a cost not to exceed one-million ten-thousand dollars, which is the estimated maximum cost of such vehicles, and levy a tax upon the taxable property of the District to pay principal, in an amount not to exceed three-hundred thousand dollars as indicated above, and interest on such bonds and notes, to be levied and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law.

**Proposition #3**

Resolved, the Board of Education of the Alexandria Central School District shall be authorized to establish a new (10) ten-year capital reserve pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 to be used for renovations and additions to all District facilities, including purchase of equipment, technology upgrades, classroom equipment and/or school infrastructure equipment, site development, storm and sanitary sewer, driveways, and parking lots, with such reserve to be funded from year to year in an amount up to the limit of the Capital Reserve Fund from (i) year-end budget surplus funds known as unassigned fund balance, as available, for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2023 and each fiscal year thereafter for the term of the reserve fund, (ii) future transfers of excess monies from Board of Education designated reserves, (iii) amounts from budgetary appropriations from time to time, and (iv) New York State Aid received and made available by the Board of Education from time to time, all as permitted by law.

Resolved, the additional sum of \$55,000 be raised by annual levy of a tax upon the taxable real property within the Alexandria Central School District for the purpose of funding the Macsherry Library
